All About Butterflies

Butterflies are flying insects. An insect has three body parts: The head, thorax, and abdomen. Butterflies have a long tongue that they use to drink nectar from plants. They use their two antennae to smell.


These beautiful insects come in many different sizes and colors. The world's largest butterfly has a wingspan of 12 inches and the smallest is the size of a nickel.


A butterfly life cycle starts out as an egg. A caterpillar then comes out of the egg. The caterpillar will eat and grows very fast. Then the caterpillar makes a hard shell called a chrysalis. Inside the chrysalis, the caterpillar changes into a butterfly. The butterfly breaks the chrysalis and comes out. A butterfly has a lifespan of 20-40 days.

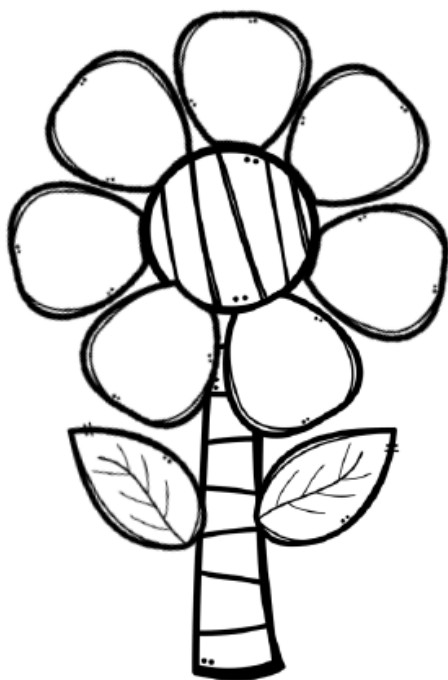
